ATTENTION: Volunteer Performers wishing to participate in Showcases at the 2020 Festival.

If you wish to participate at the 2020 National Multicultural Festival in a volunteer capacity, you have **two** means by which to apply.

1. You can complete a Volunteer Performer application form. Performers applying through this avenue will be considered for general stages. The Festival considers several factors when scheduling acts and reserves the right to decide upon the final entertainment schedule. Performers are reminded that completing this application form **does not** automatically guarantee inclusion in the program. All applicants will be subject to the Volunteer Performer Terms and Conditions.
2. You can express your desire to be part of a Showcase at the 2020 Festival, by contacting the appropriate Showcase Coordinator. The role of the Showcase Coordinator is to design their individual showcase program working with Performers and Volunteers. Performers who have already been approved or engaged by the Showcase Coordinator **need not apply through the volunteer performer application**. Showcase Coordinators are responsible for scheduling their individual programs and reserve the right to schedule all performances within their Showcase.
3. The following Showcases will participate in 2020: African Village, Bellydance, Celtic Tattoo, Chian Village, Greek Glendi, India in the City, Indigenous, Languages, Latin Quarters, Pacific Islander and United States. If you are interested in participating in a Showcase, please contact the Festival Team and your expression of interest will be passed on to the appropriate Showcase Coordinator for consideration.
